

## Erratum

In Liao and Yan article, "A Review of the Discovery, Research, and Conservation of the Formosan Landlocked Salmon (*Oncorhynchus masou formosanus*) in Taiwan" (Vol. 5, No. 2, pp. 109-130), it is found that an erroneous quotation was made at Paragraph 5, of Page 116,

"Gwo et al. (2008a) used AFLP markers in an attempt to sort out the phylogenetic relationship among four subspecies of cherry salmon: Amago (*O. masou ishikawae*), Biwa (*O. masou subspecies*), Masu (*O. masou masou*), and Formosa landlocked salmon (*O. masou formosanus*). However, their efforts failed to distinguish the differences and therefore concluded that the taxonomy and evolutionary relationships of the Formosa landlocked salmon with the other three species of the *O. masou* complex remain uncertain".

The correct quotation should be "Gwo et al. (2008a) used AFLP markers in an attempt to sort out the phylogenetic relationship among four subspecies of cherry salmon: Amago (*O. masou ishikawae*), Biwa (*O. masou subspecies*), Masu (*O. masou masou*), and Formosa landlocked salmon (*O. masou formosanus*). Gwo et al. (2008a) successfully utilized AFLP markers to distinguish among the four subspecies of the Masu salmon complex. Their findings further support the hypothesis proposed by Gwo et al. (2008a), which aligns with the view of Watanabe and Lin (1985), that the Formosa landlocked salmon originated from an ancient lake in the northern part of the Amur River, in northern China."
